Dear Bobcat Family,

It is my sincere hope that everyone is having a safe, enjoyable and productive summer. Before I begin providing information about the upcoming school year, I would like to thank everyone for your patience, support and prayers as we navigated through an extremely challenging school year. We all had to come together as a family to ensure that our Bobcat scholars had a safe and successful school year, in the midst of a pandemic, but we made it. With that being written, there is a lot less uncertainty and a lot more expected out of me as principal and the Bobcat faculty and staff this upcoming school year. We are truly excited about what lies ahead for Morrow Middle School. Here is some information that will help you to support us in being more effective this coming school year.

Dress Code

The CCPS uniform dress code policy will be enforced this year, and the specific attire for MMS is posted to our school website. Sunglasses, hats, “du-rags,” bonnets, slippers, slides, mid-drift shirts and sleeveless shirts are not permissible. Fridays will continue to be incentive days for students. Students can earn jean days by displaying Bobcat P.R.I.D.E. The Bobcat P.R.I.D.E acronym means that students are prepared, respectful, involved, diligent and efficient at all times. School administration will advise parents each week if students have earned an incentive day. Additionally, students will need to adhere to the following: students can wear jeans or school uniform (no jogging pants, joggers, tights or athletic attire).

Student Lockers

All students will be required to purchase a locker. Students are not permitted to share lockers and should not share their combination with anyone. Students can store personal and school items in their locker. Lockers are school property and are subject to unannounced search by school personnel at any time.

Campus Safety and Security

Students will be required to store their cell phones in their assigned locker during the school day for safety and security purposes. This will also increase student engagement and learning.

Clear book bags are required for all students. Student safety is our greatest priority, we strongly recommend investing in clear book bags for the upcoming school year.

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Updating Household Information

In addition to updating your household information in Infinite Campus, please complete and submit the Student Information/Emergency Release Form that your scholar will receive at the start of the school year. The form will also be available on our school website. It is vital that the information is updated because we strictly adhere to the CCPS policy for checking out students. Parents/Guardians must present a government issued photo ID to check out students, every time and without exception. Parents/Guardians of students who arrive late or after 9:00 am must come into the building to check in their child. Students should not be dropped off and allowed to enter the building by themselves. Students may be checked out for early dismissal until 3:20 pm. After 3:20 pm, students must remain in class until the 3:45 pm dismissal bell.

Lunch

Students are welcome to bring lunch from home; however, students and/or parents are not allowed to order food and have it delivered to the school. In addition, students may not have outside food (fast food, restaurant prepared food) dropped off. School prepared lunch will continue to be available free of charge.

Home Learning

Students are required to complete the following home learning each day: Students will need to complete daily homework assigned by teachers. Also, students will need to complete daily reading log and iReady (Reading and Math). Parents will need to support these efforts at home. This will assist students with learning needs as work towards academic excellence.
